Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Organisation, may be made at any time from 26/04/2024. The nomination form must then be lodged in accordance with the Organisation's rules (see below).

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than** 12:00 Noon Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) **on** 10/05/2024.

How to lodge nominations: Nominations must be lodged by email.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may choose to submit a statement along with a passport sized photograph to be included with the ballot material. Statements must be **no more than 300 words and in Microsoft Word format. Photographs should be in JPG format.** Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12:00 Noon (Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST)) on 10/05/2024 can be accepted.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 31/05/2024 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 09/07/2024.

Scrutineers

The appointment of scrutineers opens 26/04/2024 and closes 12:00 Noon Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 02/07/2024.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
